#### SECTION I - INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

- 2.1. Scope of Tender
- 2.1.1. Kimisitu PLC hereinafter referred to as the procuring entity intends to prequalify suppliers for the following Goods, Services and Small works for the Financial Year 2025 2028. Registration applications to be received by the procuring entity not later than 17<sup>th</sup> June, 2025 at 4.00 pm. Late applications shall be automatically rejected
- 2.1.2. Registration is open to eligible firms and voluntarily formed joint ventures as indicated in appendix to instructions to candidates.
- 2.1.3. General information on the candidates' qualification, human resource capital, facilities, financial capabilities to be provided are as specified in the appendix instructions to candidates.

### 2.2. Submission of Application

- 2.2.1. Interested and eligible firms who wish to participate in the registration must visit www.kimisituinvestment.co.ke; under the tab written "TENDERS". More information will be available on this link. The submission should be received not later than **17th June**, **2025** at **4.00** pm. Late applications shall be automatically rejected.
- 2.2.2. All the information requested for registration shall be provided in the English language. Where information is provided in any other language, it shall be accompanied by a translation of its pertinent parts into English language. The translation will govern and will be used for interpreting the information.
- 2.2.3. Failure to provide information that is essential for effective evaluation of the applicant's qualifications or to provide timely clarification or sub substantiation of the information supplied may result in the applicant's disqualification.
- 2.3. Eligible Candidates
- 2.3.1. This invitation for registration is open to all candidates who are eligible as defined in Kenya's Public Procurement Law and regulations and as indicated in the appendix toinstructions to candidates.

- 2.3.2. The Kimisitu Investment Company PLC employees, committee members, boardmembers and their relative (spouse and children) are not eligible to participate in the tender.
- 2.3.3. All firms found capable of performing the contract satisfactorily in accordance with theset registration criteria shall be registered.
- 2.4. Qualification Criteria
- 2.4.1. Registration will be based on meeting the minimum requirements to pass in the criteriaset as shown below. The declaration will be either pass or fail regarding the applicant's general experience, personnel and equipment capabilities and financial position as demonstrated by the applicant's response in the forms provided in Section V and submitted with the letter of application. Kimisitu Sacco reserves the right to waive minor deviations if they do not materially affect the capability of an applicant to perform the contract.
- 2.4.2. General Experience: The applicant shall meet the following minimum criteria
  - a) Average annual turnover as a supplier over the last two (2) years of Kshs. 0.5 million (Five Hundred Thousand Kenya Shillings).
  - b) Successful experience in execution of at least 3 assignments of a nature and complexity comparable to the proposed contract within the last two (2) years.
- 2.4.3. Personnel capabilities: Indicate key staff, professional qualification, experience and their functions.
- 2.4.4. The audited Accounts for the last two (2) years shall be submitted and must demonstrate the soundness of the applicant's financial position, showing long-term profitability. Where necessary the Kimisitu Investment Company PLC will makeinquiries with the applicant's bankers.
- 2.4.5. Litigation history: The applicant should provide accurate information on any litigation or arbitration resulting from contracts completed or under its execution over the last five years. A consistent history of awards against the applicant or any partner of a jointventure may result in failure of the application.
- 2.5. Public Sector companies
- 2.5.1. Any public owned enterprise may be eligible to qualify if, in addition to meeting all theabove requirements, it is also legally and financially autonomous, it operates under commercial law, and it is not a dependent agency of another public entity.
- 2.6. Conflict of Interest
- 2.6.1. The applicant (including all members of a joint venture) shall not be associated, nor have been associated in the past, with Kimisitu Investment Company PLC

. Any such association must be disclosed and may result in the disqualification of the applicant.

### 2.7. Updating Registration Information

2.7.1. Registered candidates shall be required to update the financial information used for registration at the time of submitting their bids and to confirm their continued compliance with the qualification criteria. A bid shall be rejected if the applicant's qualification thresholds are no longer met at the time of bidding.
